5. Submit I-20 Documents: Email the following information for the I-20 Certificate of Eligibility to Molly Reininger in SLC (immigrationdocs@utah.edu): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Color copy of first page (biographical page) of passport Bank statement(s) or letter from your bank issued within the last 6 months with a balance of calculated cost of 2023-24 tuition, fees, and living expenses: \$56,565 (See Canvas Module 2 for FAQs) Optional: If the bank statement is not in your name, you and the account holder must print, complete, sign, scan, and email the Affidavit of Support. Note: As long as the total amount equals the estimate above, you can submit as many bank statements as you’d like. However, for each statement, you must provide an Affidavit with the account holder’s signature. The SLC Campus cannot guarantee that you will be able to receive your visa on time if you do not submit your documents by the deadline. 6. Receive your I-20 as a PDF via email. You will need to print out your I-20 and SIGN IT for your visa interview at the US embassy.	TBD	NA

8. Apply for an F-1 Visa. Refer to Module 3 & the F-1 Visa check list.	As soon as you receive your I-20: Visa appointments book fast.
